3. **EMERGENCIES: Call 911, for non-emergencies call (920) 391-7450.** This is the Brown County Sheriff's Department non-emergency number. They can contact our local police officers to assist you.
4. **BAD WEATHER:** In case of inclement weather, the maps state that sales will be held on Sunday but that is up to you.
5. **BE AWARE:** Our rummage sale attracts everyone and not everyone is honest. Have enough helpers to watch your money at all times and your items especially those lining the driveway.
6. **FOOD SALES:** State law dictates that only people with a state license or nonprofit organizations should be selling food otherwise you are liable.
7. **TRAFFIC:** Please drive slowly and watch out for kids. To increase parking, don't park in front of your home but leave room for customers. Stay safe!
8. **NEIGHBORS:** Not everyone loves this rummage sale. Do something nice for your neighbors who put up with the rest of us.
