CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairperson Susan Selner at 2:34 p.m.

DISCUSSION ON TRAILSHEAD RENTAL FEES

Recommendation to the Village Board is to let Youth Groups 14 years of age and under use the facility at no cost.

A second recommendation was made to charge an hourly rate of \$20 per hour for 3 hours or less, or a daily rate of \$50 with a \$100 security deposit for hourly and daily rental rates.

DISCUSSION WAS ALSO HAD ON MAKING SOME CHANGES TO THE RENTAL AGREEMENT

The below changes to the agreement are recommended to the Village Board.

- There is a question as to whether or not a renter would like the option of waste removal service. This will be removed from the agreement, and must take garbage with you will be in the revised agreement.
- There is also a question as to if there will be any sound amplification equipment utilized. This will be taken out and added to paragraph 3 regarding necessary permits.
- The question of approximate number of people attending will be removed, as it states on the agreement to limit group size to a maximum of thirty-two (32) people inside the enclosed depot/shelter building.
- In paragraph 3 of the agreement it states the lessee shall not vend, sell or offer for sale any food, beverage, alcoholic beverage or any other commodity with in the shelter or park to the public without the prior authorization of the Village Administrator. Individuals or groups acquiring such authorization are responsible for obtaining necessary permits and/or licenses including noise permit if sound amplification equipment is being used for their function. Yellow will be removed, and green will be added.
