CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

BOARD DISCUSSION/ACTION ON APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEE TO FILL VACANCY DUE TO A RESIGNATION

President Mleziva explained due to the resignation of Milton Bielinski on June 4, 2018 there is a vacancy on the Village Board that needs to be filled. The position had been posted for 2 weeks in *The Denmark News* as well as on Facebook. Mleziva was pleasantly surprised by the interest level he received from quite a few of our current committee members. Ultimately 2 residents officially applied.

- Mark Nelsen – not currently on any committee

Discussion continued as to what both candidates would bring to the table. Board members felt that being actively involved in a committee was an advantage.

**Schilke/Bielinski moved to appoint Leah Goral to fill vacancy due to resignation of Milton Bielinski. Motion carried 6-0.**

BOARD DISCUSSION/ACTION ON FIREWORKS SELLERS APPLICATION FROM DENISE KARL TO SELL FIREWORKS AT 658 DEPERE ROAD

Coogle explained the fireworks permit arrived too late to put on agenda for June 4<sup>th</sup> board meeting. Application has been completed, certificate of liability insurance has been received and fee has been paid. Karl has sold fireworks at this location the past few years with no issues.

**Wertel/Bielinski moved to approve fireworks seller application for Denise Karl to sell fireworks at 658 DePere Road. Motion carried 6-0.**
