

**VILLAGE OF DENMARK  
SEXUAL OFFENDER RESIDENCE APPEAL BOARD  
JUNE 13, 2016 – MEETING MINUTES  
NOT APPROVED**

**1. Call to Order**

Chairman Bob McCabe called the meeting to order in the Village Hall located at 118 East Main Street, Denmark, Wisconsin. Mr. Swetlik said he is continuing with counseling, is a full-time truck driver, and is hoping to start his own business in the near future.

Kathy Stein made a motion to approve Mr. Swetlik's appeal. Pam Watzka seconded the motion. All were in agreement. Motion carried.

- Attorney Bouressa suggested Chairman McCabe preface the meeting by saying the offender is moving into an area / location that is restricted per ordinance.
