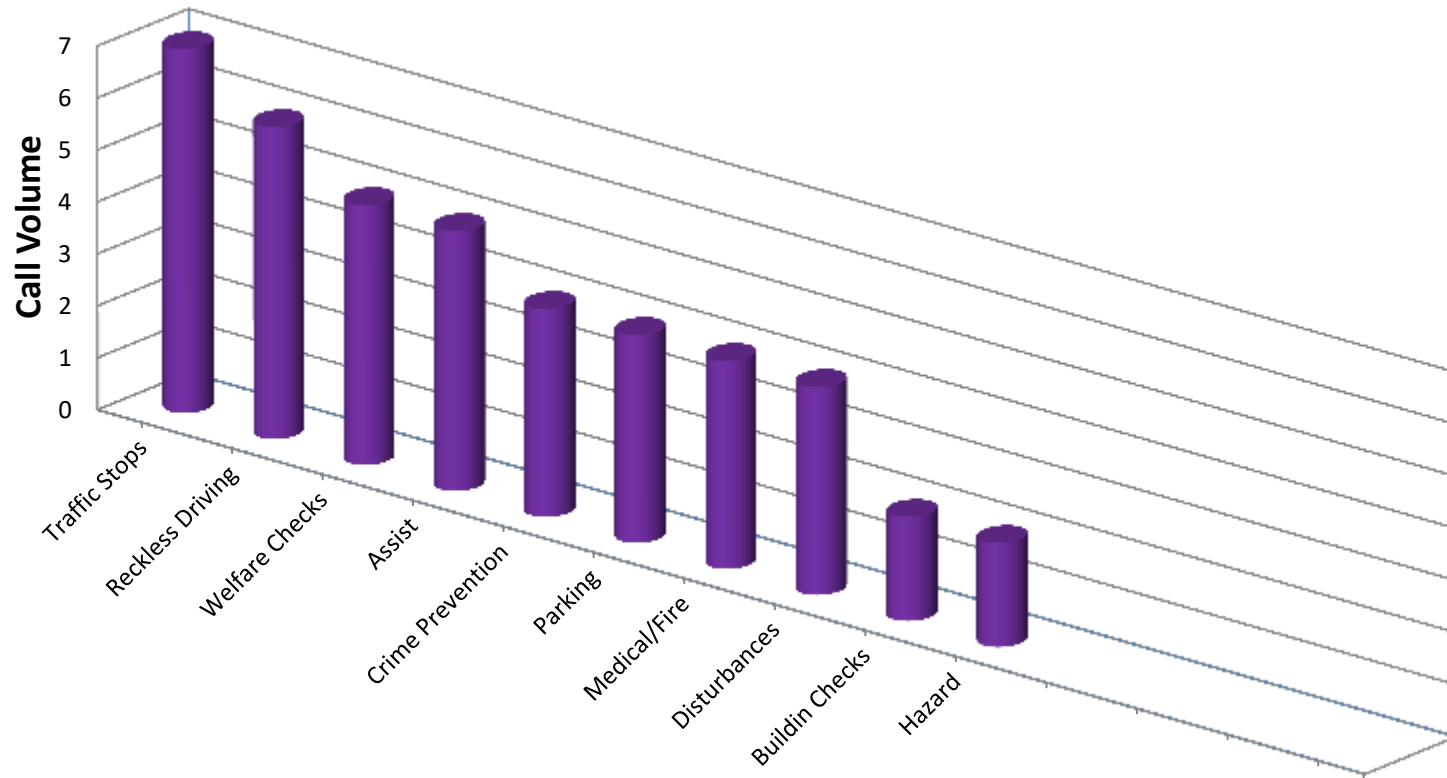
OWI ARRESTS IN DENMARK

INFORMATION BULLETIN

- **Reminder:** There is No Overnight Parking from **2:00am-6:00am** now thru April 1st.
- Winter Driving Reminder: Bridges/Overpasses/Ramps are the first surfaces to form ice. Slow down! Increase following distance! Drive defensively! Clear your windshield and windows BEFORE hitting the road!!!!
- Phone and Internet/Email scams are here to stay. DO NOT give out any personal information over the phone. Legitimate businesses and/or government agencies, such as the IRS, will never request personal information over the phone. The Scammers plan is to shock and intimidate victims into giving up personal information by threatening “arrest” or “warrants” or they may pray on your decency by telling you a loved one is in trouble in another country/state. Be VERY skeptical of all phone/email correspondence. Call **920-391-7450** for assistance from the police. The elderly are the most common target among the Scammers so have frequent conversations with your aging loved ones and educate them on how to protect their assets.
- Just a reminder to keep all vehicles, homes, and outbuildings locked. We may trust our neighbors but it is wiser to be proactive because most property crimes are crimes of opportunity. Be a good neighbor and keep an eye out for anyone or anything out of the ordinary. Many crimes, including serious ones, are solved by information provided by concerned and aware citizens.
- Does something or someone seem out of place? Concerned about speeding in your neighborhood? Contact the Village of Denmark Police/Brown County Sheriff’s Office at **920-391-7450**. The sooner the information is shared the safer we can make our Village.
- Do you have any information about suspected drug activity? Are you witnessing frequent “short-term” visitors to neighbors? Maybe you only suspect drug use or sales. Please make use of the **Brown County Drug Tip Line: 920-437-DRUG (3784)**.
